How will Hegarty help my child?

Teachers set home learning activities through Hegarty, based on their Maths lessons

- Quizzes are based on what your child has been learning at school or for revision
- Pupils can revisit a topic to practise and improve memory and maths confidence.

What if my child forgets their login details?

Once you have entered name, surname and date of birth, , click 'forgotten your password' on the password screen, now a reset my password request will be sent to your child's maths teacher.

Can I see my child's progress?


Yes, pupil dashboards show their progress including how many hours spent using Hegarty and how many questions answered correctly.












How do we access Hegarty?
